

AGREEMENT

Between

St. Luke Catholic Hospital and College of Nursing (SLCH)

And

Doctors with Africa CUAMM (CUAMM)

On

HOSPITAL ATTANEDANCE OF MEDICAL STUDENTS AND JUNIOR DOCTORS (SISM Project)

Agreement object: four weeks theoretical and practical training of Medical Students and Junior Medical Doctors c/o St. Luke Catholic Hospital and College of Nursing.

Whereas, the ECC-SADCO, St. Luke Catholic Hospital and College of Nursing in Wolisso, herein after referred to as SLCH, is committed to guarantee health service to the population, with a spirit of equity and justice

Whereas SLCH and CUAMM, in the fulfillment of the above mentioned common mission, are committed in the development of Human Resources for Health, both in Italy and Ethiopia,

Now Therefore the the two parties agree to commit themselves to cooperate in the management of the SISM Program.

1. SISM Program details

- The Participant are Students and Junior Doctors are members of SISM "Segretariato Italiano Studenti di Medicina (Italian Secretariat Medical Students), a "Non for Profit" Organization based in Bologna (Italy).
- Two participants will be attached to a St. Luke Hospital structured Medical Doctors and will follow the day to day clinical or surgical activity; if agreed by CUAMM and SLCH they could also be involved in the realization of ongoing Hospital researches or scientific protocols.
- The Department/Ward to be attached will be identified on the occasion of the introductory meeting with the Hospital Medical Director; it will take into consideration the students' curriculum, their interests/attitudes, the hospital needs.



- The First Student Supervisor is be the Doctor in charge of the ward attended: Second Supervisor will be the Medical Director, who is also the main responsible of the SISM Project.
- The maximum number of students attending the hospital will be two per month, the attendance of a third Student – upon request from SISM – will be first evaluated and approved by SLCH and CUAMM; on the occasion of extraordinary events the hospital would resolve to either reduce the number of participants or temporary suspend the programme.

2. St. Luke Hospital Responsibilities

- To facilitate the introduction of the Medical Students/Junior Doctors into the ward activity.
- On the occasion of the preliminary meeting the Medical Director (will spell out the student's task and responsibilities and Guest House regulations. In addition some issues concerning security, logistics and code of conduct within the hospital compound will be provided.
- The Doctor to whom the students is assigned will create conducive conditions for student's familiarization with the context, his/her learning and participation at the ward activity.
- The participants , upon sharing and approval from CUAMM PHC Program Manager, could also be involved in field activity carried out by the Public Health Department and visits of Health Institutions located in the Hospital area.
- To guarantee accommodation and meals within the hospital compound with the related costs being entirely covered by the student according to the latest rules and regulation and daily fee of the Guest House.
- To guarantee logistic assistance as provide transport from and to Addis Ababa Airport for participants' arrival and departure in collaboration with the Doctors with Africa CUAMM County Office based in Addis Ababa. The related costs will be covered by the students, with the following costs for the utilization of SLCH 's car:
 - week time: 50 Eur
 - Weekend time (as an exception, to be evaluated and decided by the Medical Director and SLCH): 70 Eur
- To release a certificate at the end of Student/Junior Doctor training specifying Ward/Department attended and number of dedicated hours.

3. Doctors with Africa CUAMM responsibilities

- To sign a "Memorandum of Understanding" with "Segretariato Italiano Studenti di Medicina" (SISM) defining the terms of collaboration between the two Institutions.
- To organize two preparatory meetings per year in which the initiative will be presented and relevant information to concerned or "ready to leave" Students/Junior Doctors will be provided. In the same occasions involving proposals to students who already completed the training experience will be formulated.



- To directly submit to SISM initiatives or project proposals aimed at supporting the St. Luke Hospital activity.
- To collaborate with St. Luke Hospital in the management of some logistical aspects: students time table, making available the Doctors with Africa CUAMM Guest House in Addis Ababa for students landing or taking off on the night hours (including transport from airport to CUAMM accommodations).
- To coordinate, according to the Doctors with Africa CUAMM security policy and instruction given by the Italian Embassy, any force major evacuation from the Hospital and/or Ethiopia of the students.

Doctors with Africa CUAMM, in consultation with the Hospital, in case of any misbehaving attitude and/or security reason can request the Student to immediately leave the Hospital and/or the Country.

Any misunderstanding and dispute between the Parties arising out of the implementation of this Agreement shall be settled amicably by consultations between the parties.

The present agreement will get expired two years after its signature and could be eventually modified and renewed.
